



Application for a Scholarship for the participation in the course Carbon Forestry (19 February – 08 March 2024)

The application for the scholarship will be processed independently from the application for the course. So if you are applying for the scholarship, you must also hand in the COURSE application form.

Scholarships will be granted to persons

- from developing countries or from newly industrialized countries,
- with adequate academic and professional background in forestry, as well as adequate English skills,
- a professional linkage to the working field of sustainable management of forests and carbon forestry (e.g., land use consultants, carbon project developers, staff of governmental forest administrations, NGOs, forest scientist), and
- that have a potential role (e.g., due to their positions in their home contries) as multiplicator, i.e., that can make the acquired knowledge and skills also available to other professionals/students in the field of sustainable management of forests/carbon forestry.
- that are not financially supported by their company or a project

Scholarships will be granted to the applicants that most closely fulfil these criteria. The scholarship covers

- 10% of the course fee (100,00 \in), reducing the fee for you to 900 \in
- 10 nights in a hotel in Freiburg (ca. 25 Feb-5 Mar 2024; not possible to disburse the money in cash), and
- support for living costs

<u>Please note:</u> The scholarship **does not cover** any travel costs. Furthermore, the participant will have to pay the costs for any additional overnight stays outside the 10 days by himself/herself.

12. Conditions of participation

An application is required (via registration form). Once participants have been accepted, they will receive their registration confirmation by email. Please ensure that your valid email is entered correctly on the form. All essential information will be delivered <u>only</u> via mail for registered attendees. The Chair of Silviculture / Faculty of Environment and Natural Resources will send participants a notification letter once the registration is completed.

Change/flexibility in format of instruction

The course is planned as a hybrid version with about 1.5 weeks of online and 1.5 weeks of live engagement in Freiburg. The organizers may change this envisaged hybrid format of the course in light of new dynamics regarding the pandemic situation as well as in light of travel restrictions for a significant amount of participants Non-payment of invoice sent to you is NOT recognized as a cancellation. All cancellations and requests for refunds MUST be submitted in written form by the deadlines listed within this policy.

Withdrawing from application after acceptance

Withdrawl from the application or the course can only be accepted in written form. Refund requests postmarked (date of email, fax) prior to 21 calendar days before the start of the course will receive a 50% refund. Non-payment of invoice sent to you is NOT recognized as a cancellation. All cancellations and requests for refunds MUST be submitted in written form by the deadlines listed within this policy.

Minimum number of participants and cancellation

If the minimum number of participants is not achieved, or if the course cannot take place due to *force majeure* or for other good reasons, already paid participation fees will be refunded without deduction. Further claims are excluded.

Certificates

Participants will receive a Qualified Participation Certificate and (optionally) ECTS points (if they pass all examinations).





Disclaimer

The University with it's members or agents shall not be liable for damage caused to the participants or their belongings, except that the damage was caused intentionally or through gross negligence. This does not apply to personal injury caused in this respect. There is no liability for consequential damages. The statutory provisions shall apply. In the case of invalidity of individual clauses, the other clauses shall remain valid. German law shall exclusively be applicable.

Liability/insurance

There is no liability insurance coverage for persons participating in the training program offered by the University of Freiburg.
